

## **Information for Invited Speakers and Accepted Presenters**

**AIRPORTS:** There are three airports in the vicinity: Spokane, WA (GEG) is 80 miles away, Lewiston (LWS), ID is 30 miles away, and Pullman (PUW) Airport is 2 miles away from WSU. [Wheatland Express](#) operates a shuttle bus from the Spokane & Lewiston airports, or you may want to rent a vehicle if arriving in Spokane or Lewiston. If you fly into the Pullman/Moscow airport, we can arrange for someone to pick you up.

If you wish to take advantage of the reduced governmental rates approved for Washington State University, you can contact Global Travel at 509-332-1212, and pay with your own credit card.

**HOUSING:** Arrangements have been made to house all conference participants who require housing at the [Honors College dorm – White Hall](#). The conference will be held in the lounge at White Hall.

Honors Hall has a number of different room types varying in shape, size, and whether they were designed for one person or two. Every room is part of a suite. Each suite has a common lounge area, kitchenette with microwave and refrigerator, and a bathroom/shower area. The hall also has a pool table, ping pong table, TV, a piano, a full kitchen in the basement and indoor bike storage.

**EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT:** We will reimburse reasonable transportation expenses of speakers and presenters:

- Airfare – [tourist/economy class]
- Car Rental – [if necessary]
- Ground transportation to/from airport, or
- Airport parking
