The Department of Mathematics and Statistics at Washington State University in Pullman, WA, invites applications for part-time, non-tenure track positions in Mathematics at the Instructor level beginning August 16, 2016. This is a recruitment for renewable one-year faculty appointments.

Qualifications: An earned Master's or doctoral degree in Mathematics or related field with strong emphasis in teaching mathematics at the college level is required prior to the start of the appointment. Evidence of effectiveness in teaching basic undergraduate courses with at least one year of teaching experience, including introductory level undergraduate mathematics courses and/or experience teaching mathematics content courses for elementary education majors, is preferred.

The *responsibilities* of this position include teaching up to four basic undergraduate mathematics courses on campus in Pullman, WA, per semester. Course coordination may occasionally be included in the overall teaching assignment.

The letters of recommendation will be requested and obtained from the reference provider through our online application system. Screening of applications will begin immediately and will continue until all teaching needs are met.
