

FACULTY POSITION IN MATHEMATICS EDUCATION, WASHINGTON STATE UNIVERSITY

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics at Washington State University invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track position in Mathematics Education at the Pullman campus. Appointment will be at the Assistant or Associate Professor rank. It is anticipated that the successful candidate will begin the appointment on August 16, 2017. Emphasis research areas include but are not limited to undergraduate mathematics education (RUME), teaching and learning of collegiate mathematics courses typically taken in first two years of a student's undergraduate career, and/or STEM preparation. Job duties: teach undergraduate mathematics and mathematical preparation of teachers courses and graduate courses in mathematics education, mentor students, develop independent and collaborative research, establish an externally funded research program, and publish scholarly work.

Qualifications: An earned doctoral degree in Mathematics Education or closely related field with a dissertation or documented research area in mathematics education and a master's degree, or its equivalent, in Mathematics by the date of hire; a demonstrated record of scholarly work and potential to establish a robust research program; qualified to teach courses in mathematics and mathematics education; demonstrated excellence in verbal and written communication is desirable. To be considered for Associate Professor, candidate must have served at least 6 years (72 months) as an assistant professor or equivalent. A candidate at the Associate Professor rank must have an established research program, a record of external funding and teaching experience at the undergraduate and/or graduate level in both mathematics and mathematics education.
